EU Mobility Sverige

EU Mobility Sverige is a young organization working in the field of professional development and education. It was created by a team with extensive experience in managing EU Erasmus + projects.

The owner of the company has been involved in project management for the KA1 campaign in the field of vocational education and training as well as school education for 10 years. Initially, she implemented projects under the Lifelong Learning Program, mainly Leonardo da Vinci, and since 2014 has been actively participating in the Erasmus + program, supporting the mobility of learners and staff. Her work initially consisted of cooperation with schools and applying for EU funds for projects. Then projects, such as organisation of apprenticeships, cultural programs, evaluation and dissemination of the results, have been implemented in Ireland and Sweden. The organization constantly increases the quality of the services, evaluates its activities, introduces innovations and develops its activities by cooperating with EU schools, as well as hosts students from European countries in Poland and Sweden.

8 people work in the organization, each of them has a strictly defined scope of activities in order to implement projects to the best. The company's headquarters are in Malmö. The organization of internships at this location allows for internships to be in line with the field of study and at the highest level.

The company puts emphasis primarily on the quality of the project and its implementation, providing assistance in the application process (preparation of attachments, internship program, cultural program, etc.) and actively participates in disseminating the project results and organizes internships, jobs-shadowing, preparatory and follow-up visits, according to the project program, participants' skills and in close cooperation with the workplaces, also taking into account their needs.

In 2019, the owner of the company cooperated with 60 schools, thus contributing to the organization of trips for almost 1,000 students.

An extremely important element of EU Mobility's activity is the constant dissemination of the results of the implemented projects. Thanks to this, subsequent actions taken are adapted to the needs of participants, and also have an impact on the achievement of the intended goals by relying on previous good practices. The aim of disseminating activities and presenting results is a direct impact so that potential beneficiaries and institutions learn about the benefits of implementing Erasmus + projects and can benefit from the previously developed experiences. EU Mobility Sverige uses many available dissemination tools to reach the largest possible audience. Before the start of project activities, the EU Mobility Sverige presents its previous experience in project implementation and results through multimedia presentations to potential partners and beneficiaries. Files addressed to students, parents, teachers and management staff are sent to schools and other institutions by e-mail. The purpose of dissemination at this stage is primarily to encourage schools to cooperate, present the benefits of the project for all parties, present the experience of the company and people involved in the project. It is worth emphasizing that EU Mobility Sverige will disseminate the results and promote the project on the website, as well as the fanpage in popular social media, Facebook, Twitter - these pages will include photo reports and reports on the current activities and implemented projects. The Internet is one of the most popular tools for disseminating activities and results. however, the company is not limited to this type of activity. To reach the largest possible audience, the EU Mobility Sverige uses printed materials - leaflets, brochures, folders, which are delivered to potential recipients by post or in person. EU Mobility Sverige publishes information on implemented projects and its activities in local media whenever possible (radio, press). Company representatives organize meetings, direct meetings with potential project partners, during which they inform about their activities, good practices, experience, benefits of participating in projects, and results. It is important to emphasize that the EU Mobility Sverige uses the sustainable results of the project, also after its completion. Earlier experiences in implementing EU projects have a direct impact on potential participants and organizations. The results of the implemented projects establish a good practice for future partners. Dissemination is an important factor in the development of EU Mobility, therefore the partner particularly cares about the presentation of experience, commitment and durability of the results.

the company's employees monitor implemented projects, take care of disseminating the effects of activities, and also deal with the accreditation and certification of projects.

during the preparation and implementation of the project, the company appoints a person responsible for maintaining constant cooperation with the school, taking care of participants, helping in problem situations, organizing cultural activities, preparing the necessary documents, as well as a person responsible for accommodation, food, organization of transport.

The team's responsibilities are:

- Organize apprenticeship places present a list of companies with which EU Mobility Sverige cooperates, where students will undergo apprenticeships
- Organize and monitor student accommodation
- Establish cooperation with employers and mentors at internships the internship supervisor, determine the details and program of internships with her/him, plan and carry out the evaluation process. After completing the internship, they discuss with the mentor the achieved results and skills acquired by the student during the internship.
- Prepare, in consultation with the school, project documentation (learning agreement, certificates, participate in the preparation of ECVET, Europass Mobility)
- Disseminate the project results and learning outcomes
- Organize a cultural program (trips)

Cooperation with the school at the stage of writing the application:

- Establishing the rules of cooperation, division of responsibilities of the parties
- Personal meetings, phone calls, e-mails, Skype meetings
- Project budget

Preparation of documentation for the application form:

- Letter of Intent
- Internship schedule broken down by days
- Agreement on the internship program with learning outcomes
- List of companies we work with
- Description of accommodation and meals

After approval of the project:

- Signing a contract with the school
- Redetermining the details of the stay (dates, groups, places of practice)
- Constant cooperation before the arrival of the group
- Meeting with students participating in the project (personal or Skype)

TASKS CARRIED OUT IN THE PROJECT

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EU Mobility Sverige

During mobility:

- Organization of airport transfer to the hotel and back
- Organization of hotel or apartment accommodation and meals
- Welcome meeting, cultural preparation of the participants, walk around the city, rules of stay
- Organization of apprenticeship places based on the apprenticeship program and the assumed results of practical education
- Providing an apprenticeship with a mentor supervising the apprenticeship and evaluating at every place
- Participants' progress and commitment to evaluate professional skills
- Monitoring the course of internships as well as initial, current and final evaluation (questionnaires, observations, interviews with participants)
- Organization of local transfer for students. On the first day of the internship, the students will be led by the staff of the EU Mobility Sverige to the practice sites and introduced to the mentor. Employees will show the way and show how to use public transport.
- Implementation of the cultural program 2 excursions and afternoon activities
- Preparation of certificates confirming the completion of internships and participation in the creation of documentation: Ecvet, Europass Mobility
- Dissemination of results and project promotion activities
